From the term after your child is three years old, your child is entitled to 15 hours funding in one or split between two settings.

#### For children aged 9 months to 4 years:

From September 2025, 15 hours for eligible working families will expand to 30 hours. This means eligible working parents can now apply for up to 30 hours of funding from the term after their child turns 9 months until they reach school age.
